



## PPTXtract

### Overview

PPTExtract requires a PC with Office 2007 or 2010 and later. It does not work on Macs or versions before 2007.

If you need to extract sounds and images from a PowerPoint presentation in versions before 2010 you could save as an html file. This would give you a folder full of the dependant files. Somewhere in there you would find the sounds and images!

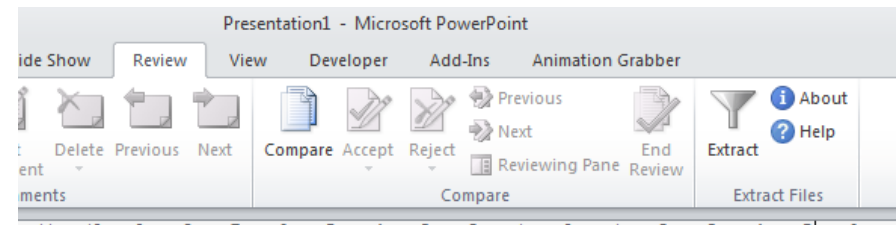
This feature was removed from 2010. PPTXtract simplifies the procedure and makes it a one click option AND catalogues the files so they can be easily found.

As well as the images used and sounds PPTXtract can recover the original image (before being altered in PowerPoint), embedded video (2010 and later only), copy all linked files to a common folder, produce a WORD file of your notes neatly typed out and also a WORD file of any comments.

### Installation

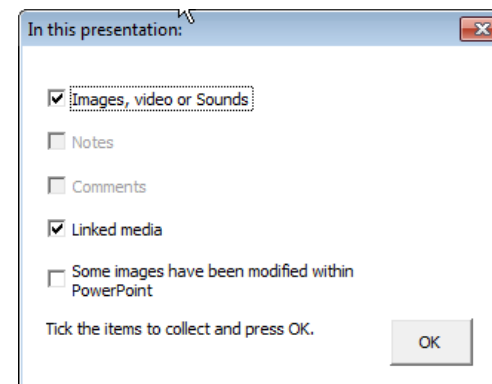
With your PowerPoint program Closed run the PPTXtract.msi installer program.

Once installed open PowerPoint and check that there is a new group in the REVIEW tab



### Use

Simply open the REVIEW tab and click the Funnel icon. On the screen that appears select the items you need. (Note: greyed out areas indicate that there were no objects of that type in the presentation). If you have edited images in PowerPoint (e.g. added a bevel, shadow or modified the color) clicking the “Some images have been modified” box will extract BOTH the original and the modified images.



Allow the program to run and then open the folder containing the catalogued files. PPTXtract will tell you where it is located and even open it for you!
